## County Mixed Foursomes Championship 2024

### TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. Each Club in the Union may enter one or two teams via Block Entry Sheet issued at the start of the season to all Clubs. The entry fee for this year's Competition will be £20.00
2. The players in each team must be of amateur status and visible on WHS as a playing member of the Durham club they are representing must not have taken part in a Championship of another County or represented another County during the previous 12 months. Team members can be changed between rounds, however, players may only represent one team in this event in the same season.
3. Foursomes matches will be played on a knock-out principle, either home or away (until the semi-finals) according to a draw(s) made before each round which will be circulated to all Clubs concerned and posted on the DCGU website. The away team will have the honour on the first tee.
4. Players will play from scratch, by foursomes match play. All matches are to play from the tees nominated by the host club - Men are to tee off on odd numbered holes, Ladies on even numbered holes. Matches will be decided by sudden death if required after 18 holes.
5. The responsibility for arranging each match shall rest equally with both clubs. Matches **MUST** be played by the date stated and in the event of a result not being notified to the County Secretary by the prescribed date, **BOTH** clubs will be eliminated unless notification in writing has been received from either or both by that date claiming the tie, on whatever grounds. In such a case the Executive Committee will decide the result of the tie according to circumstances and their decision will be final.
6. The winners of each tie will be responsible for notifying the County Secretary of the match result within 24 hours of its completion.
7. The County Mixed Foursomes Semi-Finals and Final will take place on Sun 25<sup>th</sup> August at a venue yet to be decided.
8. The Durham Mixed Foursomes Champions will receive the winner's pennant and both winners and runners up will receive mementoes.
9. Unless stated otherwise in these Conditions, The General Terms of Competition for all DCGU Championships and Competitions (available at the DCGU website) shall apply where appropriate.
10. All players must comply with the dress code and all rules of the Host Club.
11. The Committee of the Union reserve the right to refuse entry to entry to any club.
